Purpose of Study: This study is intended to help participants embrace faith through a study of the Book of Galatians and its impact on the identity and the theology of the New Testament Church and on what we believe.

Text: Galatians 3:26-29; 1 Corinthians 12:13; Genesis 1:27; Luke 11:27; Acts 1:12-14

1. What message does **Galatians 3:26-28** have in common with 1 **Corinthians 12:13**?
2. **Read Galatians 3:26-29.** How does the context of this text compare to life today in modern times? What can we learn from this as a people and as a nation?
3. It is noted that our nation is “*still hemorrhaging from open wounds of discrimination and injustice.*” *A love of diversity and a love of justice*

are not the same thing.” What does the Bible say about diversity and justice?

4. What is the connection between **Galatians 3:28** and **Genesis 1:27**?

5. **Read Luke 11:27.** What was societies view versus Jesus response?

6. How does **Acts 1:12-14** show these reordered priorities in practice? What can we learn from this?

- **Journal:** Let’s reflect. As you think about this lesson, journal about what you learned from this lesson? How can the tension in the Bible help us respond to the tension we feel in the world?
